



**ADDITIONAL ADMISSION PROCEDURE
FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025/2026
ANGLOPHONE STUDIES
DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS: UNTIL 30.04.2025**

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- The basic condition for admission to study at the Faculty of Science, Humanities and Education of the Technical University of Liberec (hereinafter referred to as TUL) is the submission of a certificate of successful completion of secondary education for Bachelor's (hereafter referred to as B.Sc.) or Master's (hereafter referred to as M.Sc.) studies or a certificate of successful completion of any type of postgraduate studies for Master's (hereafter referred to as M.Sc.) studies related to B.Sc. studies.
- As proof of the successful completion of secondary education, the applicant shall submit a copy of the school leaving certificate or diploma. A simple copy of the diploma or, if the applicant does not have the diploma by the deadline for submission, a certificate from the university of study is accepted as proof of successful completion of any type of study. You must attach the evidence of your studies to your online application form if you already have it by the closing date for online applications. Otherwise, he/she must send it electronically to the Faculty's Studies Department by the deadline specified below. An exception is made for graduates of TUL's undergraduate programmes, for whom the faculty requires the completion of a bachelor's degree.
- Candidates who have obtained a degree abroad are required to provide proof of their foreign education, which can be obtained by applying to the TUL's International Office.
- The provision of personal data in the application for studies is compulsory pursuant to Section 88 of Act No.111/1998 Coll. on Universities, as amended; in the event of failure to provide such data, the application for studies will not be accepted for processing.

CONTENT OF THE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION CRITERIA (BC.)

BACHELOR'S SINGLE-SUBJECT PROGRAMME

ANGLOPHONE STUDIES	
Form of admission examination	A written test consisting of a language part testing reading, grammar and written expression - upper intermediate level (max. 50 points) and a cultural part testing the candidate's orientation in Anglo-American realities - recommended range according to Peprník, Jaroslav: Britain and the USA, Illustrated Realities (max. 50 points). The written test requires level B2 in English according to <i>the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)</i> . Candidates who provide evidence of having obtained a language certificate corresponding to level C1 or C2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) will have this taken into account when assessing their application. The language certificate must be attached to the application form by 30 April 2025 at the latest. Documents submitted after this deadline will not be considered.
Scoring	Points will be awarded on the basis of the results of both parts of the written test, with a maximum of 100 points. Candidates will automatically receive 50 points if they produce a language certificate.
Ranking of candidates	According to the points obtained.
Conditions for admission	To obtain a minimum of 45 points and to be ranked according to the capacity of the programme.

The conditions of admission were approved by the Academic Senate of FP TUL on 25 November 2024.
